Hello Little Star Families!

As February was filled with some really, really cold days and some warm days, let's welcome March with hopeful thoughts of Springtime! It's been a fairly mild winter, but I know that all of us at Little Stars and the children are ready to get back outside to play! Just a couple of reminders as we march into March...

-Be sure to check the monthly calendar for special events, activities, and holidays/school closures. We have fun filled activities, Free Dress Days and guest visitors each and every week planned for your child(ren). Also, we post reminders on the front door! Also, I send a weekly email at the end of each week detailing the next week's events....please read the email to know what is happening school wide as well as in your child's class.

-Please be sure to have your child(ren) come to school in seasonal appropriate clothing. With the warmer weather, we will attempt to get outside two times a day. Outdoor time is beneficial to all as it helps strengthen gross motor skills, provides physical exercise and enables the children to participate in both small and large group activities with their classmates.

-Label everything....sweaters, coats, clothing, diapers, water bottles, everything. Every Friday, we have quite a collection set out in the classrooms of items that have been left behind. PLEASE make sure everything has your child's name or initials on it.

-Please be sure to hang your child's coat and/or backpack under their own cubbie box. It's great for the children to be able to identify where their own belongings are located in the classroom.

-Check your child's cubbie to make sure that you have a least one set of extra clothing. We do not have extra clothing at school.

-Every child from Toddlers to Pre K should have their own water bottle. We also ask that the water bottles ONLY have water in them. And of course, make sure that the water bottles are labeled with the child's name. We want to be sure to keep the kiddos dydrated!

-Remember safety in the parking lot. Please be sure that only adults open the door in and out of the building so that your child is with you at all times. We need to also remember to drive slowly through the parking lot.

CURRICULUM CORNER

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Throughout our Curriculum, all ages focus on a S.T.E.A.M. activity the incorporates Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics into a week long activity done cooperatively or individually. In January, the Preschool and Pre K children became "Little and Big Scientists" during our S.T.E.A.M. Night exploring the Ocean. It was such a fun night for all that we wanted to share Three Lucky Leprechaun S.T.E.A.M. activities with all of you:

<u>St. Patrick's Day Fluffy Slime...the lucky leprechaun is sharing his homemade fluffy slime.</u> Ingredients:

-3 cups of Shaving Cream -Green Food Coloring -1/2 cup of Elmer's Glue (Must be PVA Glue) -Gold Glitter or Confetti -1/2 teaspoon of Baking Soda -1 tablespoon of Saline Solution -Bowl, spoon, measuring cups and spoons How to make Fluffy Slime:



1.Measure 3 cups of Shaving Cream into a bowl. 2.Add drops of Green Food Coloring to the Shaving Cream. Add a few drops at a time until desired color.

> 3.Add ½ cup of Elmer's Glue to the Shaving Cream and gently mix in. 4.Add Glitter or Confetti to the mix.

> > 5.Add ½ teaspoon of Baking Soda to the mix.

6.Add 1 tablespoon of Saline Solution to the mix and start whipping.

7.Once mixture is thoroughly whipped, begin to knead the slime in your hands. Add some saline solution to your hands to prevent sticking.

Create a Leprechaun Trap:

Have your child use his/her engineering skills are needed to build a leprechaun trap because the local leprechaun has been causing all kinds of problems. The Leprechaun Trap can be made from recyclables, paper towel tubes, paper and so much more! Since leprechauns don't like to be seen, the trap will have to be able to be triggered when he's not looking!

LEPRECHAUN GOLD HUNT!

Going on a Leprechaun Gold Hunt...we going to find some GOLD!! Ingredients: -Black pots for Gold -Gold Coins -Gold Clitter -4 tablespoons of Baking Soda -2/3 cup of water

-1/2 cup of Vinegar -Green Food Coloring -Small Spray Bottle


How to Find the Gold Coins...

1.In the Black Pot, add a few Gold Coins and Gold Glitter.2.Add 4 tablespoons of Baking Soda and 2/3 cup of Water to the Black Pot. Put aside.

3.Make Magic Leprechaun Spritz by pouring 1/2 cup of Vinegar in a spray bottle then add a couple of drops of Green Food Coloring. Shake to mix together.

Spray the Black Pot with the Magic Leprechaun Spritz to reveal your Pot of Gold! Were you Lucky??
